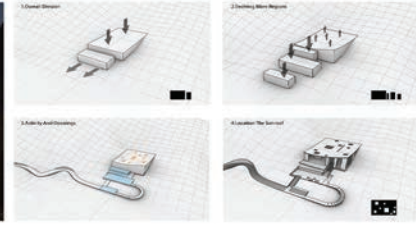
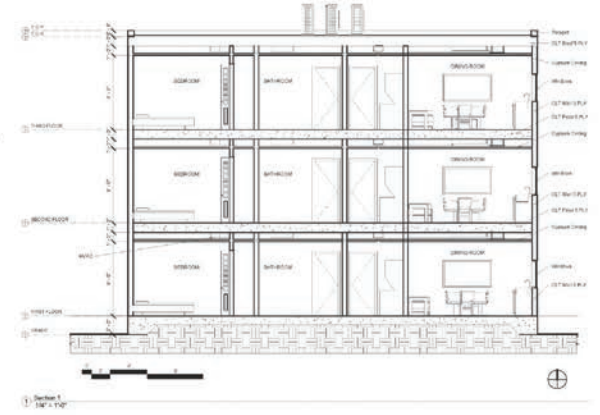
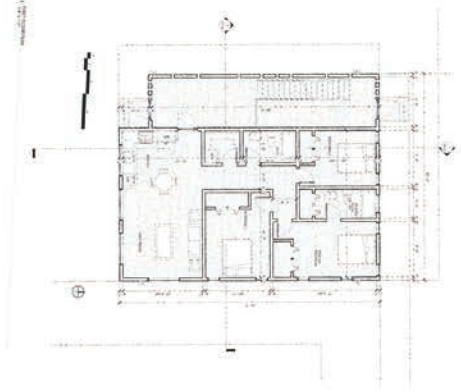


Figure 1 shows the elevation difference of the site after extracting the site selection data. Changes divide the overall volume of the building.

Figure 2 Changes the height of the defined body according to the terrain height difference. The size is meticulously differentiated into the specific size of various spaces, changing the arc of the top surface of the building.

Figure 3 The roof is combined with the position of the skylight to merge with the water. The blue part is divided into open design production. It becomes an open observation platform from the outside, just facing the Taihu Lake. It couldn't be better for the viewing platform.

This wide opening of stairs that shrinks as it rises was conceptualized six separate times in order to study its interaction with the building to the fullest potential. Once upon the elevated balcony there is a slit running along the opposing wall and when looked through offers a beautiful view of the battlefield. It is because of how meaningful this threshold and window placement are to the monument that I chose to cut the cube in half vertically to analyze the interaction one would have with the architecture if built. Finally we see the colored rendering of the project to the right in which I used complementary colors of several shades to fully express this building's light and form.

Paraline Projections

At first glance, Aldo Rossi's Monument to the Resistance is a deceivingly simple 12 meter cube placed on a green platform. However, the strategic architectural design allows the monument to not overshadow the events of Cuneo, yet allows one to go on a journey honoring the partisan fighters of World War II. To the left, I have sketched axonometric views of the monument at 45, 30, and 60 degrees and the same views in section. The entrance up into the massive cube is open and large, and the walk up the stairs slowly encloses forcing the participants to the center to a small threshold.
